## Julie B. Book Dies Thursday

Mrs. Julie Elizabeth Boudin Book, wife of Captain Julius L. Book of New Orleans, died at Hotel Dieu Thursday, April 16, at 3:30 a. m.

Mrs. Book, 40, the daughter of Mrs. Elizabeth Boudin of Bay St. Louis and the late Peter Boudin, was a native and resident of Bay St. Louis for most of her life. She moved to New Orleans two years ago.
