Mrs. Ladner is survived by three sons, Lloyd L. Ladner and R. J. Ladner of Lakeshore and James Ladner, Hollywood, California; one daughter, Mrs. Beulah Potts of Lakeshore. She also leaves six grandchildren.

Mrs. Ladner was among the finer characters of this county and her family have the sympathy of the community in their loss.

Corinne Walters was a daughter of Theodore Walters and Josephine "Nancy" Sanderfer.

She first married Charles L. Green, son of Jessie Joseph Green and Fannie Welch. The couple had one known child, Clarence Eugene. Clarence was born in 1904 and died in May 1905, a month after his father.

Corinne then on December 22, 1907 married Randolph Ladner, son of Victor Guillaume Ladner, Jr and Elizabeth "Winnie" Yarborough. Randolph had been the godfather of Corinne's son, Clarence. Corinne and Randolph's known children were Lloyd Lionel, Randolph J., James and Beulah.
