Mrs. Andrezine Favre, wife of Aristide Favre, survived by husband, son and five daughters, died at the family home Tuesday, after a brief illness, and was buried on Wednesday, Rev. Father Thuot officiating. The surviving daughters are Mrs. M. Combel, Mrs. E. Thorn, Mrs. A. Strong, Mrs. James H. Breath, Mrs. Aristide Ladner. Her demise is deeply regretted, and the relatives have a wide circle of friends who console with them in the loss of their relative.

Burial location at St. Mary Cemetery is presumed to be in the Bordages plot based on initial location on the HCHS website and is identified today as S2-03-01.
