**YOUNG COLORED WOMAN STRICKEN ILL
AT CEMETERY DIES.**

Louise Jackson, colored, a daughter of the late Augustin Rochon family, while attending a funeral at Cedar Best Cemetery Tuesday forenoon, was taken ill. While on her way home located corner Hancock and Goodchildren sts. dropped in the street opposite Geddes' undertaking establishment and into which place she was carried until taken later to her home nearby.

A physician was immediately summoned, and in answer to the poor woman's own request a priest was also sent for who duly administered the last sacrament of the Roman Catholic faith.

From 12 to 3 o'clock her condition grew worse until the end came. Death was due to an internal rupture or strangulation, and the attending physician gave a certificate of death accordingly.

Louise Jackson, was born May 10, 1887. She was a worthy young woman, industrious and of the better class of her race; and is survived by her husband.

The funeral took place Wednesday afternoon, interment at St. Mary's cemetery, with ceremony at the church of Our Lady of the Gulf.
